Speaker at Club Meeting on Friday January 8th at 7:30 PM

Robert J. "Relic Bob" Painter

Bob lives in Orange Co. Virginia with his wonderful wife Terry. The whole family hails from West Virginia. Bob has been metal detecting for almost 50 years, ever since 1972 when he put together a Heath-Kit detector and took it to Chancellorsville, VA. In his former life's



work Bob was a Federal Coal Mine Accident Investigator where he participated in the investigation of some of the Nation's most tragic mining disasters. This work however also allowed him to travel and detect many places in the US. Now 50% retired he metal detects as much as possible. When he moved to Orange Co. VA in 1978, his goal was to recover old coins, however he kept finding Civil War relics more so than coins, hence the nickname "RelicBob". Over his many years in the metal detecting hobby Bob has contributed articles to the Western & Eastern Magazine, North/South Trader's Civil War Magazine, the American Digger magazine, and the Virginia Numismatist Quarterly. Bob currently works for the North South Trader's Civil War magazine facilitating the bi-annual magazine and numerous trade shows. More recently he co-owns an enterprise "Civil War Metal Detecting Seminars" created with the view to give new detectorist a professional start into the hobby. At a seminar, the participant receives a world class detector, a reference library, classroom instruction specific to both the detector and to relic hunting, all lodging, and meals, and a one-day trip to Civil War relic site.
